Poster Presentation Faculty Fieldwork Advisor Sign-Off**

Each MPH student is required to make a formal poster presentation of his/her fieldwork project for review by the faculty, site preceptors and fellow students. Presentation of fieldwork research **REQUIRES written approval by the student's Faculty Fieldwork Advisor**. To be eligible, a student must have an approved final draft of their paper, an approved abstract, an approved poster for presentation, and have completed a dry-run presentation for their Faculty Fieldwork Advisor. Upon completion of these requirements, the student's Faculty Advisor must sign-off on the form below to ensure the student is properly prepared. This form must then be filed with the Graduate Practicum Director on their campus. Once this form is completed the student's name will be added to the list of students to present at the upcoming Fieldwork Poster Presentation.

Note to Faculty Advisor: By signing below, you attest to the fact that this student has submitted an acceptable complete, final draft and final approved abstract of their paper, as well as a poster meeting the requirements listed below, and that the student has successfully completed a "dry run" of their presentation with you and is ready to present at the Fieldwork Poster Presentation.
