To: New Jersey County Superintendents of Schools **Re:** Integrated Pest Management Coordinator Training

Dear Superintendents:

The School Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Act, which became effective on June 12, 2004, requires all New Jersey schools below college level to designate an IPM Coordinator to oversee pest control activities within their school(s) or district.

Once designated, the IPM Coordinator must complete DEP-approved training. Several training sessions will be offered across New Jersey during the upcoming school year.

While the training is required for IPM Coordinators, it has also proven highly beneficial for other school officials. In particular, School Principals, Board Members, and Trustees of Charter Schools are strongly encouraged to attend, as they serve as site managers for their schools and share responsibility for IPM activities with the school or district's IPM Coordinator.

If you were not previously aware of this, it is a good indicator that you may benefit from this training. Others who may benefit from the IPM Coordinator Training are those who oversee the day-to-day activities of the IPM Coordinator, such as the Local School District Superintendents, Business Administrators, and Facilities Directors. These titles require an awareness of the duties an IPM Coordinator is charged with in achieving compliance with the State Law, so that priorities may be properly stated and the stage set for success. Some school districts, after completing the training have named additional IPM Coordinators for their school district, since the training identified the numerous duties of the IPM Coordinator.

Training sessions are free and filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Each half-day session runs approximately four hours and includes: a review of the regulatory aspects of the School IPM Act, guidance on implementing IPM Programs, and advice from industry professionals and Rutgers Cooperative Extension. Participants will receive DEP certification, which fulfills the training requirement for IPM Coordinators.













School IPM Coordinators: 2025-2026 Training Schedule

Integrated Pest Management (IPM) training sessions are offered for school IPM Coordinators and other school personnel with administrative responsibilities related to the IPM law. IPM Coordinators receive certificates of attendance to fulfill the MANDATORY training requirement as stated in the NJDEP Pesticide Control Program regulations at N.J. A.C. 7:30-13.3. Training does not need to be repeated annually; though people may keep up-to-date by attending annually. The sessions help IPM Coordinators implement the IPM law in areas such as: non-pesticide pest management, parental notification, the 72-hour notification rule, low-impact pest management; record keeping, and pest emergencies. Participants receive 4 Continuing Education Units (CEUs). Facilities Managers with CEFM certification should note that the 4 CEUs help fulfill the NJDOE requirement that 20 CEUs must be earned within a three-year period to maintain certification.
